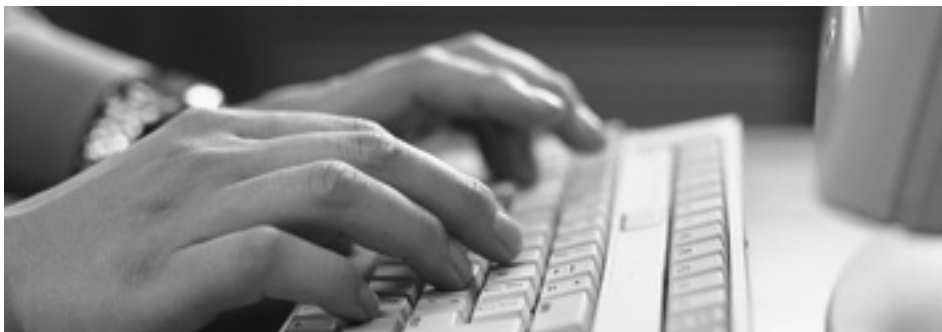

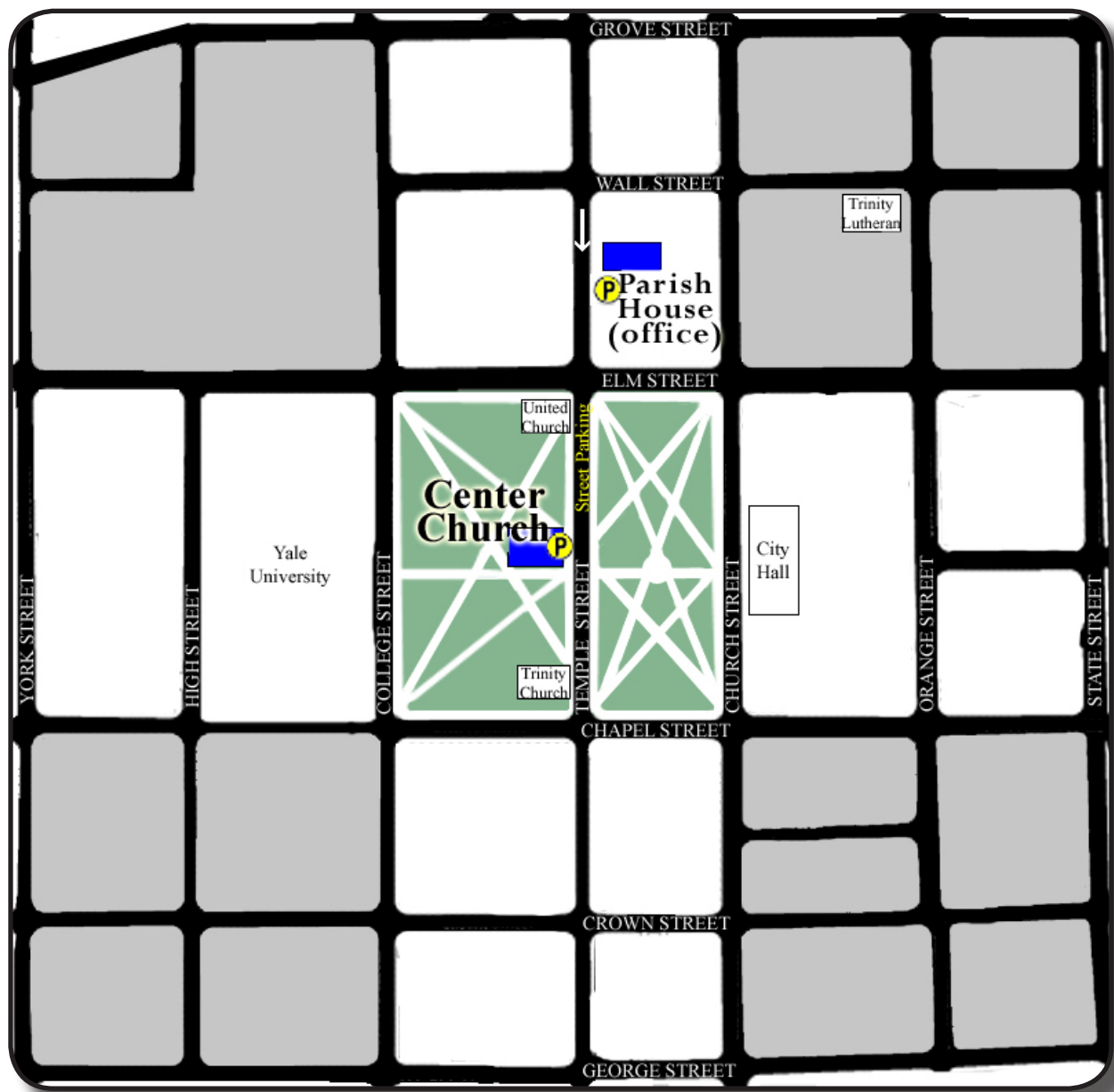

LOCATION

Center Church is located in the heart of New Haven, Connecticut on the beautiful Green.

Parking:

Free lot parking is available in front of the Church Meeting House building. Street parking, which is free on Sundays, is also available on Temple Street and around the Green.

DIRECTIONS

Directions From I-91 (North or South): Take Exit 3 - Trumbull Street

Go straight on Trumbull Street for one block, and take a left onto Temple Street. The Parish House is on the left side of the street, and the Church Meeting House building is on the right side, about one block further.

From I-95 (North or South): Follow the signs in New Haven to I-91 North (towards Hartford) and follow the directions for I-91 above.

From Hamden: Take Whitney Avenue south into New Haven (it then becomes Temple Street). The Parish House is on the left side of the street, and the Church Meeting House building is on the right side, about one block further.
